UPDATE

Upcoming Overnight I-95 Northbound Closures for I-95/SR 896 Interchange Bridge Girder Installation

Newark – The Delaware Department of Transportation (DelDOT) announces that the dates for the overnight full closure of northbound I-95 for steel girder installation originally scheduled for April 2, 3, and 4 have been moved to April 9 through April 11 (weather permitting).

In addition to the northbound I-95 closure, multiple lanes on southbound I-95 will be closed during the girder installation. All ramps onto and off of I-95 at the SR 896 Interchange except for northbound I-95 to SR 896 will remain open during this time. The northbound I-95 detour is shown below:



To complete girder installation for this span, overnight multi-lane closures on southbound I-95 and overnight closure of the SR 896 on ramps to southbound I-95 will be in effect from April 8 through April 10 (weather permitting).
