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I-95 / SR 896 INTERCHANGE – UPCOMING CLOSURES

The Delaware Department of Transportation (DelDOT) announces overnight multi-lane closures and rolling roadblocks on southbound I-95 (Tuesday through Thursday) for traffic management activities including shifting traffic lanes and installation of overhead signage. There will be overnight lane closures on southbound SR 896 for crossover construction (Wednesday and possibly Thursday). There will also be overnight lane closures on northbound and southbound SR 72 (Tuesday through Thursday) for bridge work.

DATES AND LOCATION (WEATHER PERMITTING)

I-95 IMPACTS

- **Tuesday May 27 through Thursday May 29:** Daytime lane closure, **NB I-95** from the SR 896 Interchange to the Service Plaza (9AM – 5PM)
- **Tuesday May 27 through Thursday May 29:** Overnight multi-lane closure, **SB I-95** from Service Plaza to SR 896 Interchange:
 - **Tuesday May 27 (7PM – 5AM)**
 - **Wednesday May 28 (7PM – 6AM); Rolling Roadblocks (11PM – 5AM)**
 - **Thursday May 29 (if needed) (7PM – 6AM); Rolling Roadblocks (11PM – 5AM)**

SR 896 IMPACTS

- **Wednesday May 28 and Thursday May 29:** Overnight lane closure, **SB SR 896** between Welsh Tract Road and the I-95 Interchange
 - **Wednesday May 28 (8PM – 5AM)**
 - **Thursday May 29 (11PM – 5AM)**

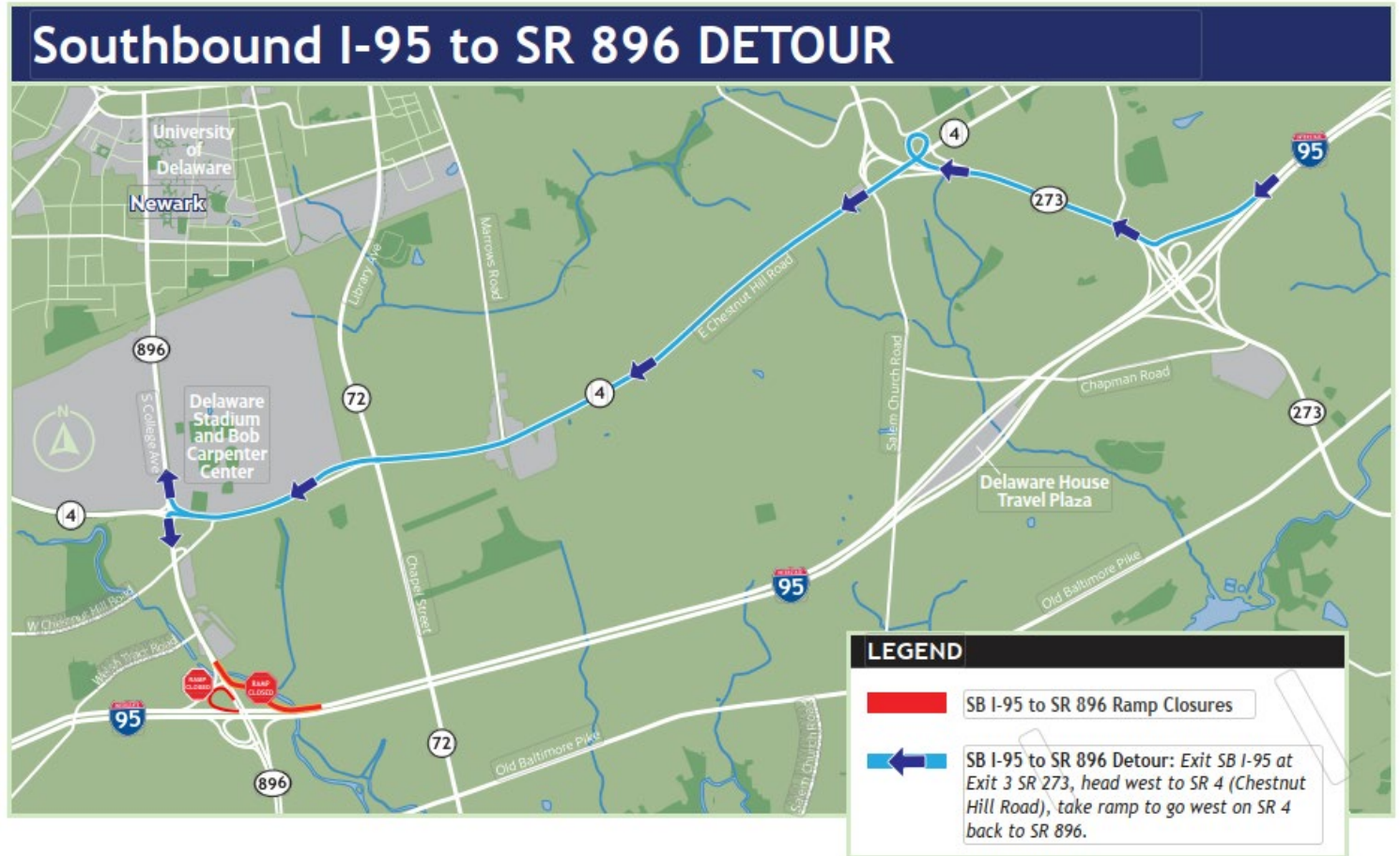
SR 72 IMPACTS

- **Tuesday May 27 through Thursday May 29:** Overnight lane closure **NB and SB SR 72** between Scottfield Drive and Peoples Drive (7PM – 6AM)

UPCOMING RAMP CLOSURES AND TRAFFIC PATTERN CHANGES

(Tentatively overnight from Tuesday June 3 into Wednesday June 4 weather permitting)

Overnight Tuesday June 3 into Wednesday June 4 the current exit ramps from I-95 southbound to SR 896 northbound and southbound will be closed to allow for final striping and signing to be installed for the opening of the new ramps. This work is weather dependent. Additionally, a new “contra-flow” traffic pattern will be initiated on SR 896 just north of the interchange.
