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Upcoming I-95/SR 896 Interchange Traffic Pattern Changes

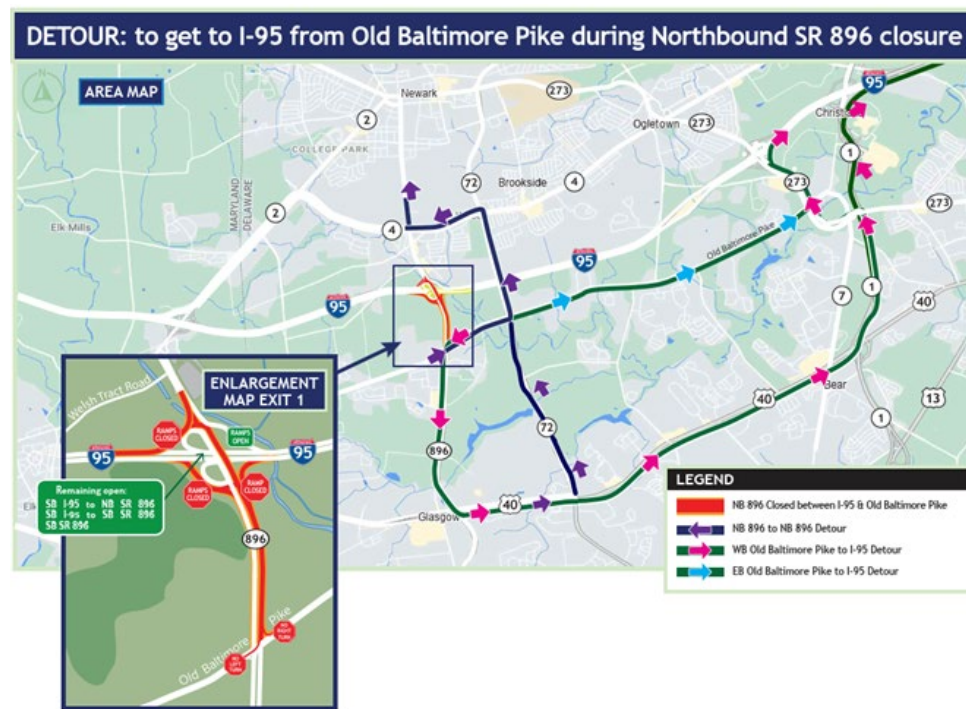

RAMP OPENING: The new SR 896 southbound to I-95 northbound ramp will open to traffic.

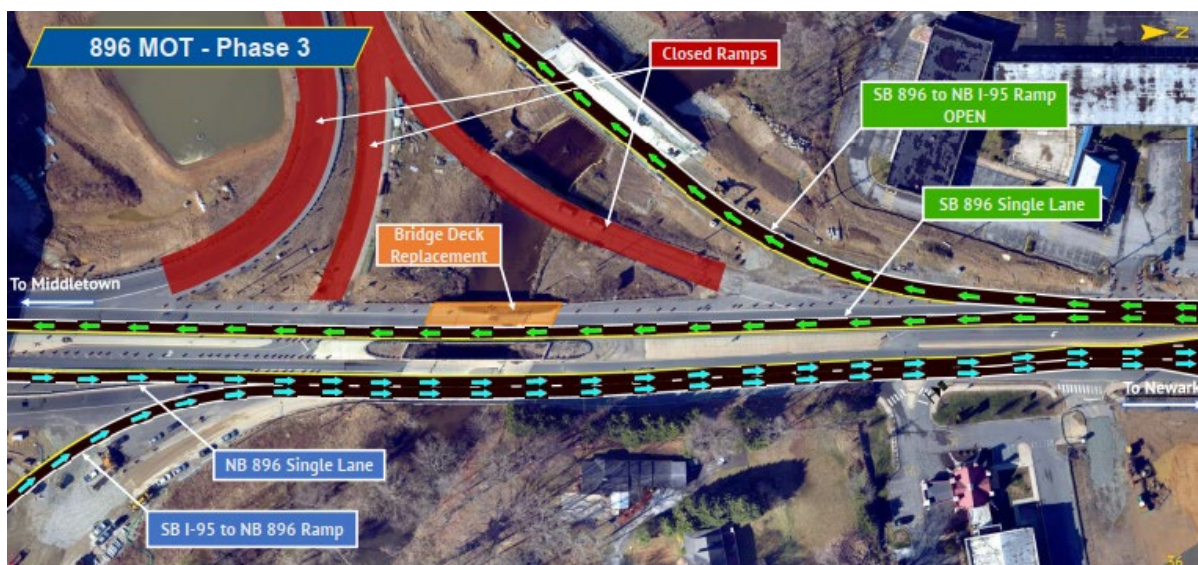
