### I-95 / SR 896 INTERCHANGE - UPCOMING CLOSURES

The Delaware Department of Transportation (DelDOT) announces overnight multi-lane closure on I-95 southbound (Monday - Wednesday) for concrete barrier work, overnight lane closure on I-95 northbound (Thursday) for concrete barrier work, overnight lane closures on southbound SR 896 for barrier removal (Monday – Wednesday) and overnight lane closures on northbound and southbound SR 72 (Monday – Thursday) for structure painting work.

- Thursday October 9: Overnight Lane Closure, NB I-95, Toll Plaza to I-95 Interchange (6PM 6AM)

#### **SR 896 IMPACTS**


Monday October 6 through Wednesday October 8 (Wed. if needed): Overnight Lane Closure, SB SR 896,

#### **SR 72 IMPACTS**

 Monday October 6 through Thursday October 9: Overnight Lane Closure, NB and SB SR 72 between Bellevue Road and Brookhill Dr. (7PM – 7AM)

# **UPCOMING SR 896 NORTHBOUND AND RAMP CLOSURE**

Northbound SR 896 between Old Baltimore Pike and the I-95 interchange and the northbound SR 896 to northbound I-95 onramp are tentatively scheduled to be closed overnight Tuesday October 14 into Wednesday October15 and overnight Wednesday October 15 into Thursday October 16 to implement new traffic pattern on northbound SR 896 and install an overhead sign structure. (All work weather permitting)
